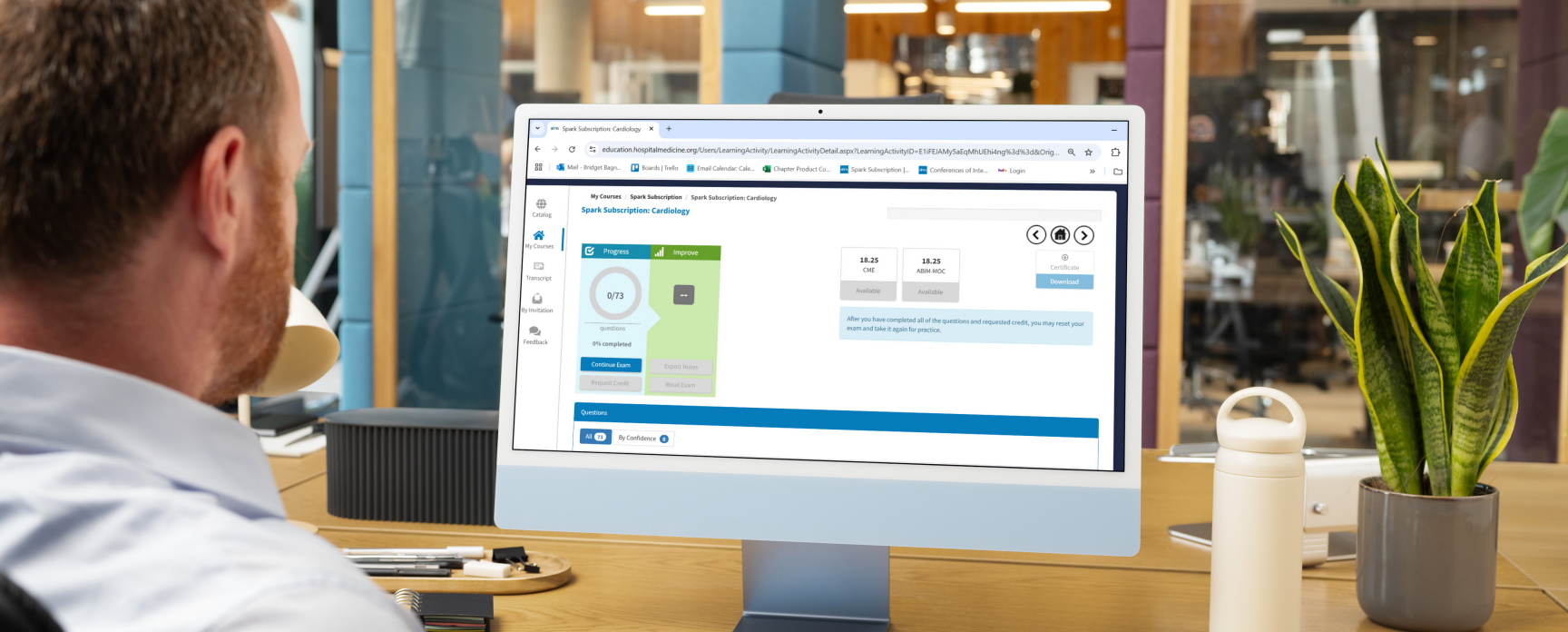
When you join SHM, not only will you gain a home, but you will become a part of a larger movement that impacts the lives of hospitalized patients through innovation and collaboration.

The Journal of Hospital Medicine (JHM)

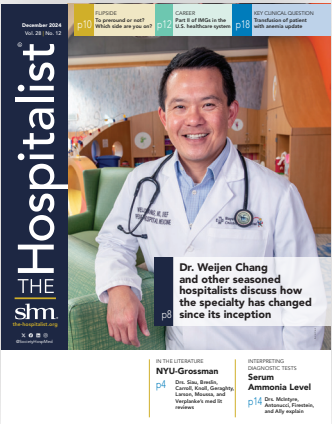

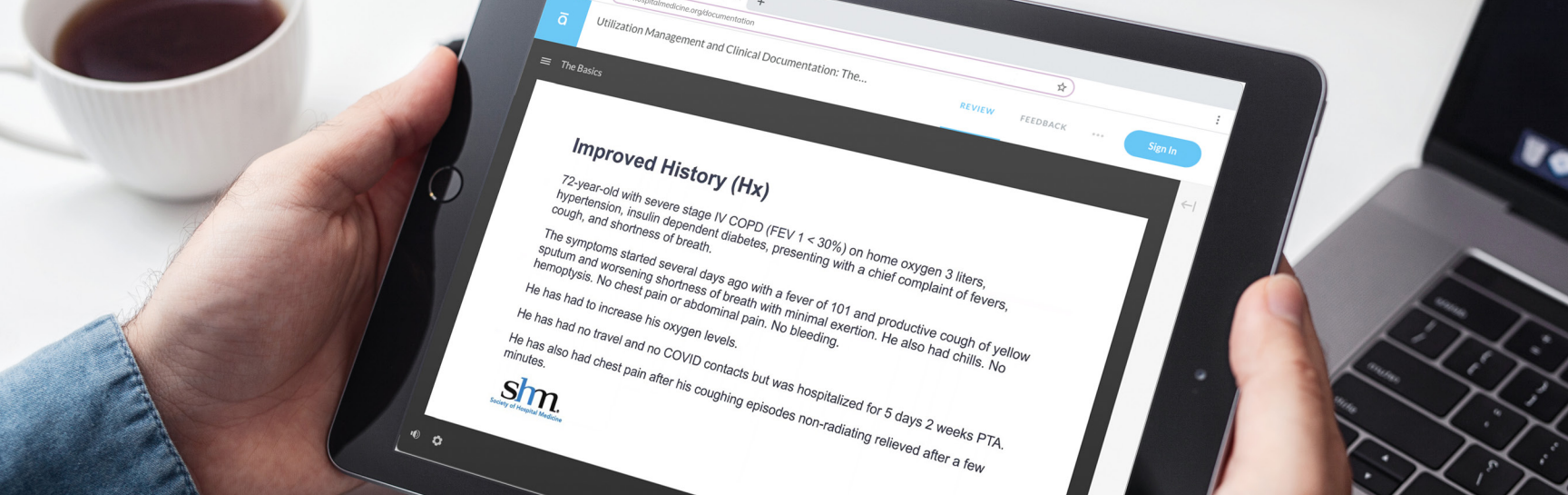
