SHM is inviting all SHM Chapters to sponsor up to two Chapter members to join us in a day of Advocacy Action on Capitol Hill on Thursday, October 16, 2025. This invitation extends to all Chapter members - attendees must be SHM members but do not need to be Chapter leaders. No experience is necessary; learners and residents are welcome.

What to Expect

Thursday morning starts with an in-depth briefing, including information about the issues we will take to the Hill and preparation for meetings with Congressional offices. Following the briefing, each attendee will head to Capitol Hill for meetings with the offices of their respective Representative and Senators.



SHM Hill Day Details

Date: Thursday, October 16, 2025

Time: 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. (end time will vary)

Location: Morning briefing and breakfast will take place at the American College of Surgeons DC Office Building on Capitol Hill. The address is 20 F St, NW, Washington, DC. The office is within walking distance to all House and Senate office buildings.

Cost: \$300 per Chapter attendee (up to two). If Chapter is sponsoring attendee(s), funds will be transferred from Chapter accounts upon confirmation of attendee information.

Travel & Lodging: Attendees are responsible for making their own travel and hotel arrangements. It is highly recommended that all attendees arrive on October 15 due to the early start time on October 16. SHM can provide a list of recommended, close hotels.
